**Depression care:** In Northern California, Elizabeth, age sixty-six, was referred by her primary care provider to a depression care manager who, as part of the IMPACT model, helped manage her medications, coordinated with her doctors, and provided counseling. For the first time in more than twenty years battling depression, Elizabeth has begun to feel better.
