

## Unsubscribing from *Health Affairs* E-Alerts:

Unsubscribing from E-alerts is easy! Depending upon what kind of alerts you're receiving you can easily remove yourself from our lists just by entering in your email address. Here's how:

### To unsubscribe from eTOCs, Topic Collections, and/or Cite Track alerts

From our e-alerts page, click on the "sign up for..." button for the alert that you are receiving now. For example, if you are receiving our bimonthly table of contents, but no longer wish to be on that list, click "Sign up for eTOCs."

This will take you to the sign-up page for this topic. Please scroll down to "Sign Up for eTOCs with your E-mail address." Then type your e-mail address in the box below and click the "Unsubscribe" button to the right of the e-mail field. You will then be off our e-mail list. You can always return to this page if you would like to sign up to receive these notices again.

#### eTOCs - "electronic Table of Contents"

eTOCs is a free service providing table of contents or a notification of availability when new issues of *Health Affairs* are published online.

Once you have entered your User Name and Password you can:

- ▶ click "Subscribe" to create your eTOCs
- ▶ click "Edit Settings" to modify your eTOCs
- ▶ click "Unsubscribe" to stop your eTOCs

##### ▶ Sign Up for eTOCs with your E-mail Address

Once you have entered your e-mail address you can:

- ▶ click "Subscribe" to create your eTOCs
- ▶ click "Edit Settings" to modify your eTOCs
- ▶ click "Unsubscribe" to stop your eTOCs

This same procedure is followed for CiteTrack and Topic Collections. Just click on the corresponding buttons for these notices on the e-alerts page.

### To Unsubscribe from *Health Affairs* alerts for Web Exclusives, Grant Watch Notices, Press Releases, Special Announcements, and Library Notifications.

Again, go to the e-alerts page, and click "Sign up for Announcements."

You will then see a page where you can type in your e-mail address where it says "Existing Users."
